

The University of Portsmouth Men's Football Club

Job Description - 3rd Team Coach

Purpose of the Role

The University of Portsmouth Men's Football Club comprises 5 competitive teams who play against other Universities in the South East. The club are looking to recruit a coach to lead their 3rd team for the season, who compete in the South Eastern Tier 3A league. The successful candidate will be available to deliver weekly training sessions from September - April, and attend and manage fixtures where possible.

The club has a variety of training sessions with room to move teams about depending on the availability of the appointed coach. Training is likely to be on Tuesdays 4-6pm or Fridays 8-10pm. To be discussed at interview.

Fixtures take place on Wednesday afternoon, locations vary. If you are only available for training sessions, that will be considered.

Main Responsibilities:

- Work with the club coaches to plan and deliver the club trials
- Plan, deliver and evaluate weekly training sessions for the 3rd team
- Communicate effectively with the Team Captain and players regarding team selection
- Attend fixtures and manage the match-day squad where possible
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

Criteria:

- Essential: FA Level 2 (including up to date Safeguarding & First Aid) or UEFA C
- Essential: Previous coaching experience
- Desirable: Working towards, or have obtained, UEFA B licence
- Desirable: An understanding of Men's Football in Higher Education
