Job Description - 2nd Team Coach

Purpose of the Role

The University of Portsmouth Women's Football Club are looking to recruit a coach to lead their 2nd team for the season. The successful candidate will be available to deliver weekly training sessions from September - April, and attend and manage fixtures. The team compete in the South Eastern Tier 2A league against other Universities throughout the season.

Training sessions take place on Mondays, 8pm - 10pm at Langstone Campus, Furze Lane, PO4 8LW. Fixtures are scheduled for Wednesday afternoons (times & locations vary).

Main Responsibilities:

- Work with the 1st team coach to plan and deliver the Pre Season programme
- Work with the 1st team coach to plan and deliver the club trials
- Plan, deliver and evaluate weekly training sessions for the 2nd team
- Communicate effectively with the 2nd team Captain regarding team selection and the relevant players
- Attend fixtures and manage the match-day squad
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

Criteria:

- Essential: FA Level 2 (including up to date Safeguarding & First Aid) or UEFA C
- Essential: Previous coaching experience
- Essential: A passion for Women's Football
- Desirable: Working towards, or have obtained, UEFA B licence
- Desirable: An understanding of Women's Football in Higher Education
